Players

We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game. As a player you have a big part to play. Longridge Town Juniors ask every player to follow a Respect Code of Conduct.

When playing football I will:

- Always play to the best of my ability.
- Play fairly - I won't cheat, complain or waste time.
- Respect my team-mates, the other team, the referee or my coach/manager.
- Play by the rules as directed by the referee.
- Shake hands with the other team and the referee at the end of the game.
- Listen and respond to what my coach tells me.
- Talk to someone I trust or the club welfare officer if I am unhappy about anything at the club.

I understand that if I do not follow the code, then the following actions may be taken by my club, the County Football Association or the Football Association,

I may:

- Be required to apologise to my team mates, the other team, referee or team manager.
- Receive a formal warning from the coach or club committee.
- Be dropped or substituted.
- Be suspended from training.
- Be required to leave the club.

In addition:

- My Club, County FA or FA may make my parent/carer aware of any infringements of the code of conduct.
- The FA/County FA may impose a fine and suspension against my club.
